

SUGGESTED ORDER OF ENROLMENT SERVICE

Chaplain: The Aim of the Girls' Brigade is to help girls to become followers of the Lord Jesus Christ and, through self control, reverence and a sense of responsibility to find true enrichment of life.

(Captain will now come forward)

Chaplain: Realising the call of Christ and the responsibility of the duties involved in this office, do you desire to serve the Girls' Brigade for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom among girls and the promotion of the aim for which the organisation stands?

Captain: I do.

Chaplain: I now enrol you as Captain of this Company and, on behalf of this Church, promise to support you by our Prayers and co-operation so that the ideals of the Girls' Brigade may be achieved.

(Chaplain will shake hands with the Captain who remains standing for enrolment of Lieutenants and Company)

Lieutenants will now come forward:

Chaplain: Lieutenants of the [INSERT COMPANY NAME] Company of The Girls' Brigade Ireland realising the call of Christ and the responsibility of the duties involved in these offices, do you desire to serve the Girls' Brigade for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom among girls and the promotion of the aim of the Girls' Brigade?

Lieutenants: We do.

Chaplain: I now enrol you as Officers of this Company and may God grant you grace to be faithful to your charge and crown your work with success.

(Officers return to their pews)

(Captain now presents the Company and asks them to stand)

Captain: Sir, I present these girls who desire to be enrolled as members of the 5th Company of the Girls' Brigade.

Chaplain: Girls, desiring to be enrolled as Members of the Girls' Brigade do you promise, with God's help, to obey the rules of the Company and to set an example of good conduct to your comrades and other girls?

Girls: We do.

Chaplain: I now enrol you as members of the Girls' Brigade. May Jesus Christ, the Captain of your Salvation, give you strength to be faithful to duty, loyal to your comrades, strong in times of temptation and His faithful servants always.

(Captain returns to her pew and the girls sit down)

Chaplain: Prayer of Dedication or Lord's Prayer.
