What you need to do:

Practice singing the songs with the backing track

Once you're ready, put on your GB uniform – casual or formal


You will need two devices (one to play the backing track and one to record) and ideally someone to help with recording

Listen to the track through a set of headphones

It's really important that the only sound on the recording is you singing – we shouldn't be able to hear the backing track

Get someone to record you singing

The video should be landscape (i.e. if using a phone, hold it horizontally)



Your face and upper body should take up most of the screen.

Listen when the track says '1,2,3' and then join in saying '2,2,3' and then continue singing to the end

You can sing a harmony that fits in with the track if you like, but just singing the track is fine

Be sure to give a big shout of Merry Christmas at the end!
